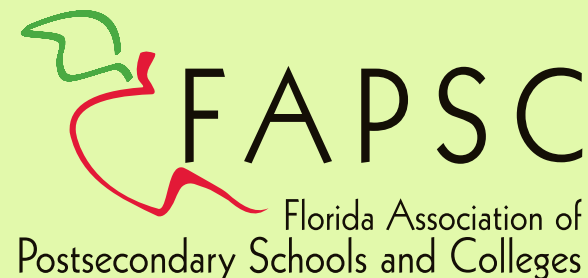

## Committees

Each committee is comprised of members with focused interests in a particular facet of the association. All committees are made up of chair and co-chair positions and a team of volunteers ready to make an impact in serving their sector. Volunteering gives you the opportunity to share ideas, make valuable contacts and promote private career education.



### Awards:

This committee administers the Annual FAPSC Awards Program, recognizing their colleagues according to the policies established by the board of directors. Members are responsible for promotion of the awards program and selection of recipients.

### Continuing Education/Conference:

Committee volunteers assist with curriculum development for all training and educational programs. The C.E.C. hosts regional workshops and the annual conference/tradeshows.



### Legislative/ Advocacy:

The legislative committee creates forums where members can examine legislative and regulatory issues. This group also monitors, evaluates and recommends positions to be taken on laws, rules and regulations affecting activities of the private career schools and colleges in Florida, and hosts FAPSC Day legislative activities.

### Member Services:

This committee promotes FAPSC to increase the number of school, associate and professional members and retain current members. Their efforts also focus on developing services that meet members' needs. FAPSC regional initiatives fall under the direction of this committee. Board appointed regional chair and co-chairs assist with town hall meetings and serve as mentors for schools in their region.

### Nursing:

FAPSC formed the Nursing Committee in 2009 with a mission to support quality nursing programs in our sector. This new committee will work to identify topics and issues that need to be addressed, and ways to share best practices through hosting sessions at conferences, webinars and through regional events. The FAPSC Board will continue to support the mission of this committee, and seek ways to assist member and non-member schools to offer quality nursing programs that help meet Florida's need for nurses.

### Public Relations/Communications:

This committee coordinates coordinates all the communication about the activities of other committees within our association. Their primary focus is to promote and execute effective communication efforts for the sector and FAPSC members and students. This committee also oversees the FAPSC Public Relations Council, a forum comprised of public relations representatives of FAPSC member schools.
